

Fletcher Moot 2023 Competition: Timeline

Entry and written submission phase

Invitations to compete & registrations open: By 1 September 2022

Problem released: By Thursday 1 September 2022 17:00 GMT

Deadline for requests for clarifications: Friday 30 September 2022 17:00 GMT

Clarifications released: By Friday 14 October 2022 17:00 GMT

Registrations close: Friday 21 October 2022 17:00 GMT

Written submissions close: Friday 28 October 2022 17:00 GMT

Finalists announced: By Friday 2 December 2022

Oral rounds (virtual via Zoom)

Deadline for qualifying teams to register for the oral rounds: Friday 16 December 2022

Deadline for submission of outline arguments (appellant): Friday 20 January 2023 17:00 GMT

Deadline for submission of outline arguments (respondent): Friday 3 February 2023 17:00 GMT

Oral rounds: Between Saturday 18 February 2023 and Sunday 26 February 2023

Finalists will be advised of the full schedule for the virtual moots during January 2023. There are 16 finalists. Each team will have the opportunity to argue twice, once as appellant and once as respondent in a preliminary round.

The eight highest-ranking teams after the preliminary round will advance to the quarter-finals, the winners of the quarter-finals will advance to the semi-finals, and the winners of the semi-finals will contest the grand final. **As this is an international competition, virtual moots will need to be scheduled across time zones at times convenient to the judges, teams should please note that they may be required to compete at unsocial hours.**

All timings are subject to change. Any changes will be publicized via the competition website and notified to registered teams by email.
