Finalists will be advised of the full schedule for the virtual moots during January 2024. There are 16 finalists. Each team will have the opportunity to argue twice, once as petitioner and once as respondent in a preliminary round.

The eight highest-ranking teams after the preliminary round will advance to the quarter-finals, the winners of the quarter-finals will advance to the semi-finals, and the winners of the semi-finals will contest the grand final. As this is an international competition, virtual moots will need to be scheduled across time zones at times convenient to the judges, teams should please note that they may be required to compete at unsocial hours.
